Due to the amendments to and expiry of the Policies and Procedures for the Bachelor and Master Continuation Programmes at FNSPE of the CTU in Prague, to be in force from the Academic Year 2022–2023, students are not obliged any more to submit the Bachelor Projects and Master Theses in bound hard-copy version.

As from 19 September 2022, no Bachelor Projects and Master Theses will be accepted in any other but electronic version (in pdf format) and shall be submitted only via the KOS System. Provided, however, a publication deferral of the work was proposed (by virtue of Art. 47b, par.4 Act 111/1998 Coll. on Higher Education, as amended), student shall submit both a bound hard-copy version and electronic version of the respective work.
