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Regulation of the Vice-dean for Student Affairs

Admissions to the Study Programmes and Recognition of Courses Offered in the
Bachelor and Continuation Study Programmes of the Faculty of Nuclear

Sciences and Physical Engineering of the Czech Technical University in Prague

Art. 1 Introductory Provisions

1.1 The Directive concerns students and prospective applicants for a place at the Faculty of Nuclear Sciences and Physical Engineering of CTU in Prague (further referred to as "FNSPE") who failed to complete some of their previous courses and are seeking readmission to a Bachelor or Master Programme.

Art. 2 Course admission requirements and recognition of courses

- 2.1 Submission of applications follows the Faculty's Regulation on Admission to Bachelor and Continuation Master Programmes, and announcement of the alternative and extraordinary admission term to these programmes.
- 2.2 Student shall terminate his/her current Study Programme no later than by the day preceding the day of enrollment for the new Programme.
- 2.3 On enrollment, student may apply for recognition of courses successfully passed in the previously taken Programme.
- 2.4 In accordance with the Study and Examination Rules for Students at CTU Art. 13, par.10, recognition applies only to courses completed within a period of five years but no later (referred to the day of re-enrollment for a new Programme).
- 2.5 For recognition of courses it is essential for the student to submit an application to the Study Office.
- 2.6 Upon the submitted application, automatic recognition shall apply only to courses taken and passed at FNSPE for which student
 - was awarded an end-of-unit assessment only (except for the Bachelor Project or Master Thesis seminars and courses related to these, semester projects, research projects, i.e. typically courses coded BP12, VU12, and DP12),

or

- was awarded a graded assessment or passed an examination, as the case may be, graded A, B, or C.
- 2.7 Possible recognition of other courses rests with the Head of Department which guarantees the respective Study Programme student seeks to join.
- 2.8 If student seeks recognition of courses taken and passed at another faculty of CTU or other institution of higher education, the application shall be proven and accompanied by a transcript and syllabi of passed courses verified and confirmed by the respective institution.
